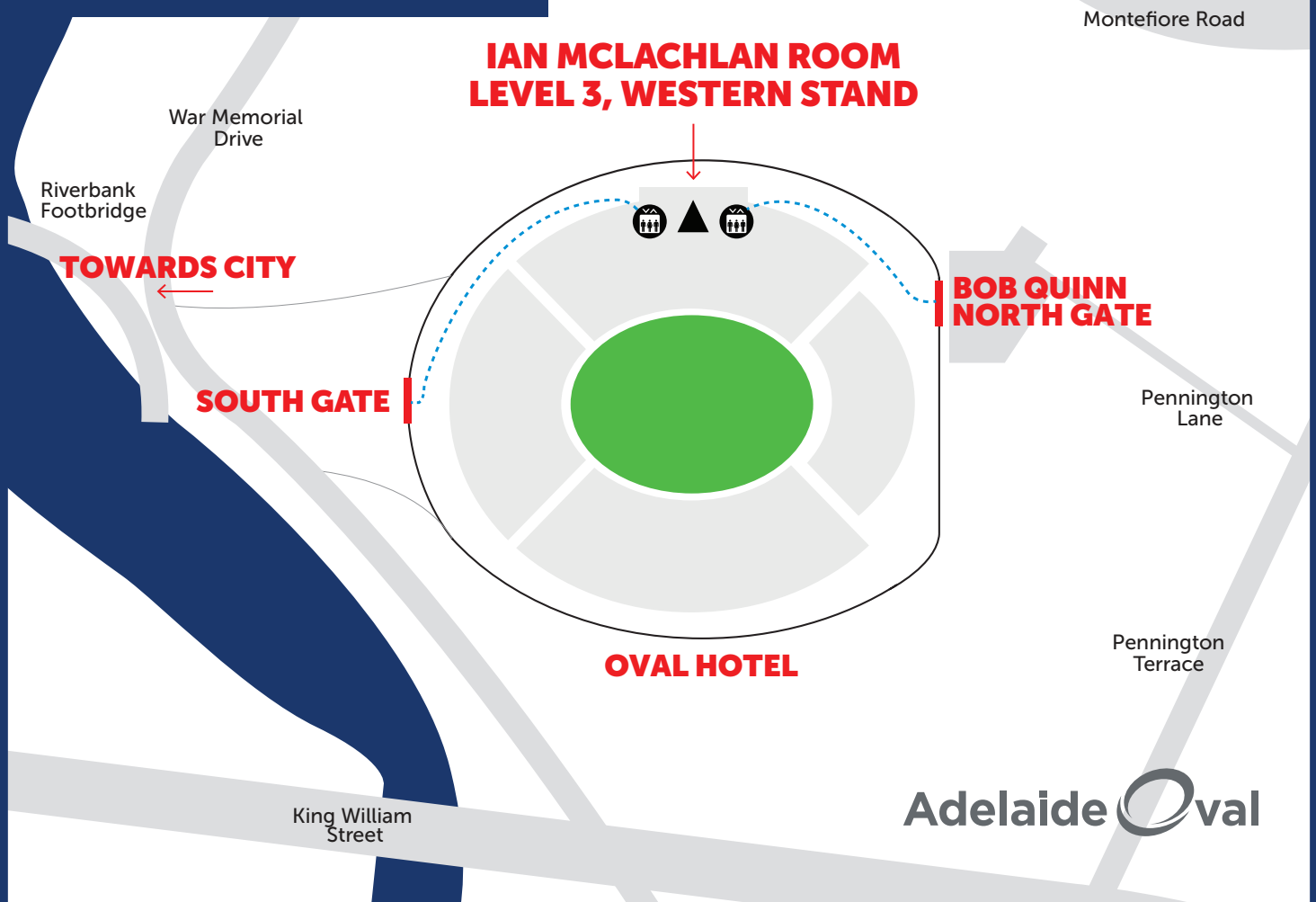

VENUE LOCATION

The venue for ASU National Conference 2024 will be held at the **Adelaide Oval**, in the **Ian McLachlan Room**. The venue is a 15-minute drive from the Adelaide airport.

ENTRY POINTS

There are two entry points into the oval, the South Gate and the North Gate. The North Gate is the closest entry to the Ian McLachlan Room and is just off Pennington Terrace. The South Gate is on War Memorial Drive. The Ian McLachlan Room is on level three of the Western Stand.

ONE CONVENIENT VENUE

The Welcome Reception and Dinner will be held at the same venue.

ONE CONVENIENT LOCATION

ASU National Conference 2024 is only a short walking distance to the official accommodation at the Oval Hotel. It's also a lovely, short stroll to the Adelaide CBD.

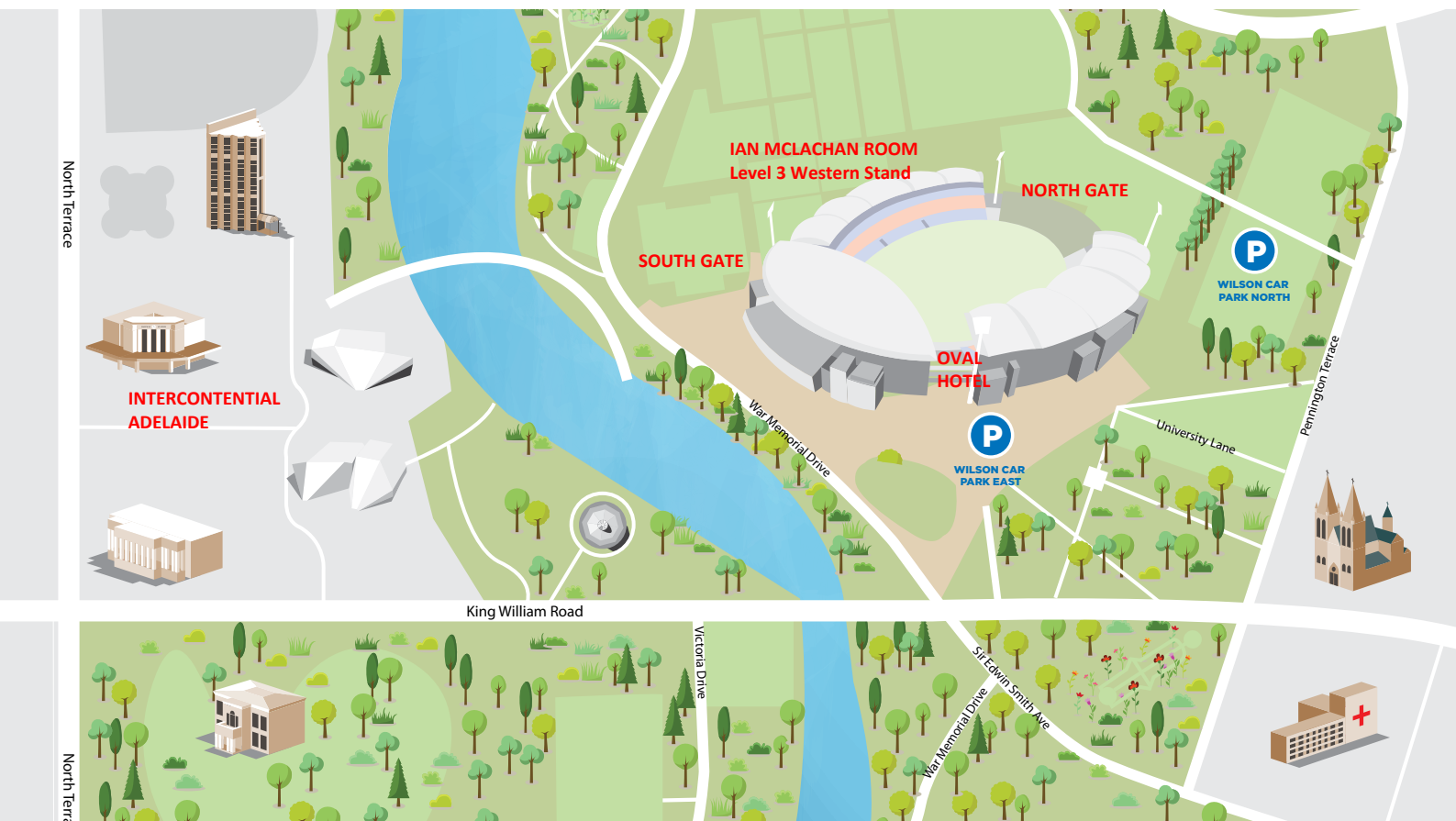

CAR PARKS

There are two Wilson Parking car parks located at Adelaide Oval:

WILSON EAST CAR PARK

Entry via King William Road.

Take the lifts to Level 1 and enter via the South Gate and follow the directional signage to your function room.

WILSON NORTH CAR PARK

Entry via Pennington Terrace, North Adelaide.

Enter through the Bob Quinn Gate and follow the directional signage to your function room

CHARGES

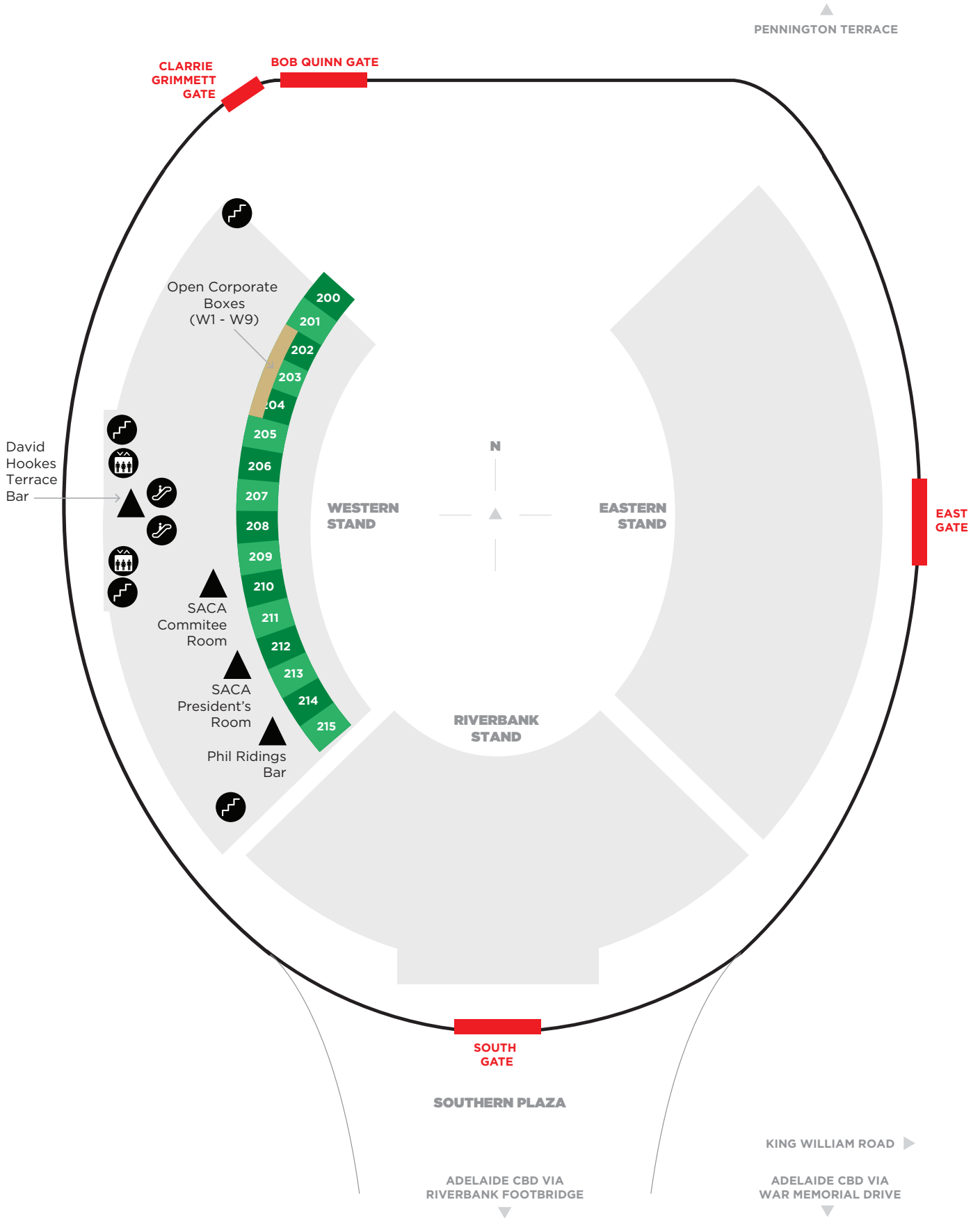
A special function rate of \$18.00 per car (plus credit card fees) per day can be offered. To receive this rate, guests will need to take a ticket from the boom gate on entry to the car park (do not insert your credit card) and validate their ticket before they leave the function room or the public casual parking rate applies. Casual parking starts from \$9.00.

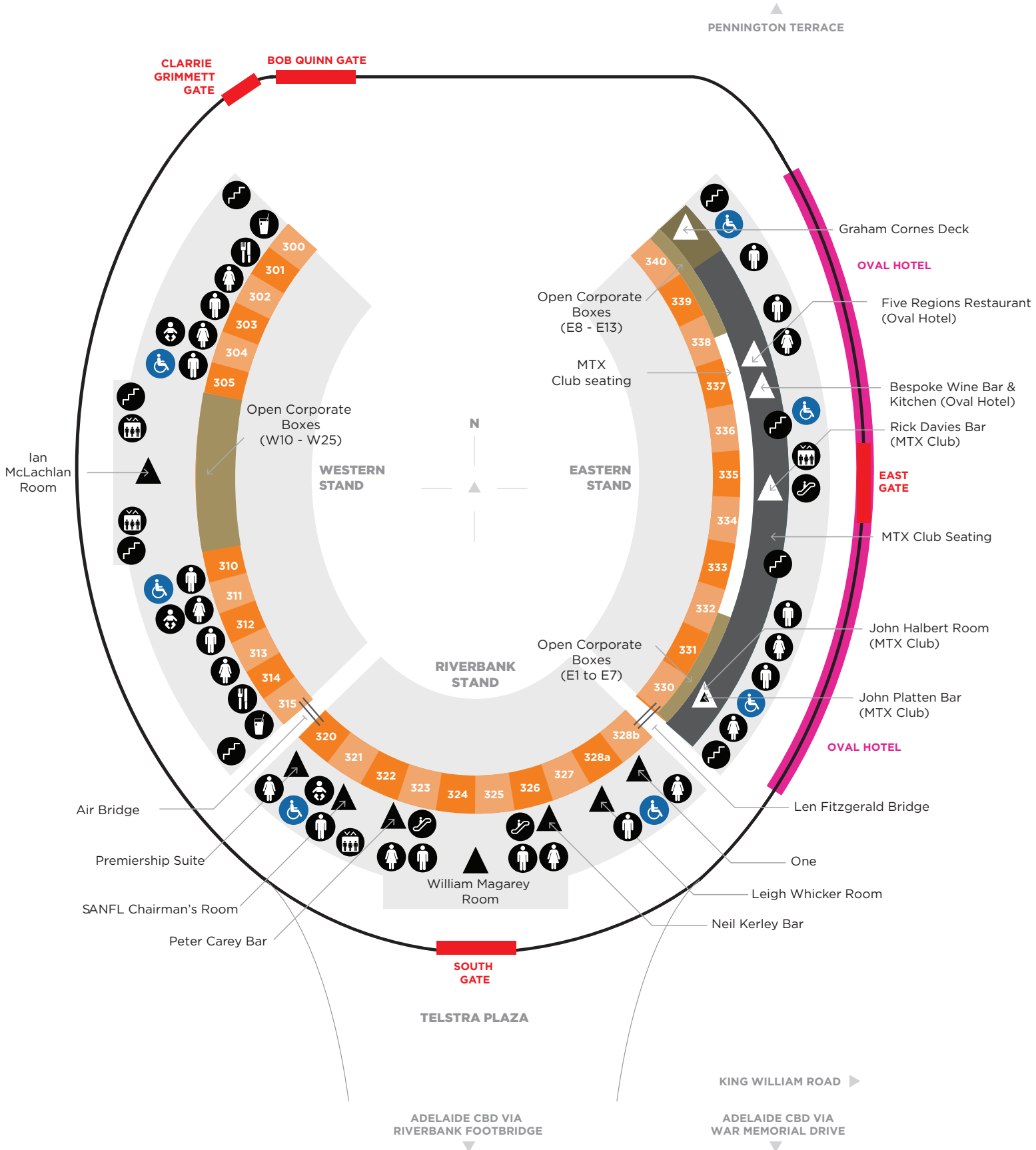
Please check with your function supervisor for the location of the validator.

Car parking is limited and available on a first come, first served basis. There is limited ticketed on street car parking nearby and some guests may choose to walk over the Riverbank Footbridge, entering from the Telstra Plaza on War Memorial Drive.

ADELAIDE OVAL EMERGENCY EVACUATION PROCEDURE



EVACUATION PROCEDURE

UPON HEARING THE ALERT TONE (STAND-BY)

An audible (beep) beep tone - means stand-by, gather your personal belongings and await further instructions.

EVACUATION TONE

An audible (whoop whoop) tone - means evacuate the building under the guidance of Adelaide Oval staff.

1. Listen to staff or warden's instructions.
2. Look for the green & white illuminated signs which indicate the way out.
3. Proceed by the safest route to the ASSEMBLY AREA.
4. Assist persons with disabilities as necessary.
5. Do not re-enter the building until instructed by authorities (All Clear) to do so.

Adelaide Oval maintains a strict non-smoking policy; smoking and/or vaping are permitted solely outside the venue gates
