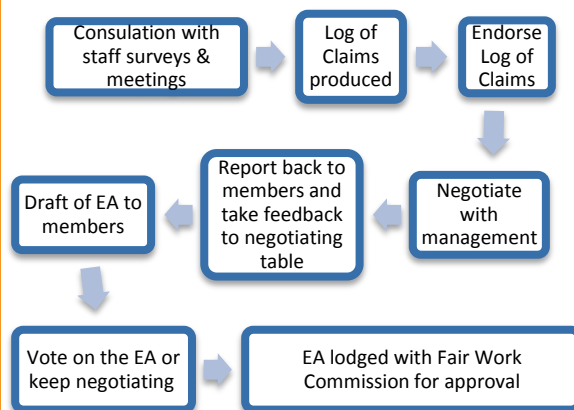
Negotiations are scheduled to commence on **2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2014 in Brisbane.**
