**NOTICE SETTING OUT THE PARTICULARS OF THE ALTERATIONS
TO THE RULES OF THE AUSTRALIAN MUNICIPAL, ADMINISTRATIVE,
CLERICAL AND SERVICES UNION
REGULATION 126**

**DECLARATION
REGULATION 126 (2)**

I, PAUL SLAPE, of Ground Floor, 116 Queensberry Street, Carlton South, Victoria, 3053, state:

1. I am National Secretary of the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union (“ASU”), an organisation of employees registered under the Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009 (“the Act”) and I am authorised to make this statement for and on behalf of the ASU and to sign the “Notice Setting out the Particulars of the Alterations to the Rules of the Union”.
 2. The particulars set out in this “Notice Setting out the Particulars of the Alterations to the Rules of the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union dated Friday, 20 August, 2010, lodged herein are correct.
 3. The alterations were made in accordance with the Rules of the ASU.
 4. The manner in which compliance with the Rules of the ASU was obtained is as follows:
 1. At a meeting of the National Executive held 6-7 July, 2010, it was decided to amend the Industry and Eligibility Rule (Rule 5) of the Union.
 2. Arising out of the discussion a resolution was carried authorising the National Secretary to submit the proposed rule change to a vote of National Executive in accordance with ASU Rule 8 National Executive.
 3. This rule provides that a motion may be submitted to National Executive by letter, telegram or facsimile, or electronic mail and the decision so obtained upon such motion shall have the same effect as a decision made by resolution of the National Executive passed at a duly constituted meeting (see rule 8 j.).
 4. The Rule alteration involves adding a new Part XX II to sub rule 5 b, Eligibility for Membership to the Rules of the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union, as follows:

“PART XXII

Person engaged in the State of New South Wales in the generation, transmission, distribution and/or retailing of electricity.”
 5. On Tuesday 10 August, 2010 in accordance with Rule 8j. I, as National Secretary, determined to submit the rule alterations to an electronic mail vote of National Executive.
 6. In accordance with Rule 49, the National Executive carried the rule changes by a majority of votes cast in accordance with Rule 8 and the vote was declared on Wednesday 18 August 2010. A total of 111.5 votes were received supporting the rule change. Zero negative votes were received. The total number of votes on National Executive is 126 with a majority needed to carry a resolution being 64.
5. I confirm that a notice advertising this rule change has been published on the ASU National website, www.asu.asn.au.

6. I declare that the particulars set out in this notice are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
